Football Championship Official Rule-book

This rulebook is binding and will be strictly followed in the course of the tournament

A. List of Events: Football (Men)

B. Schedule of Events: 26th March - 29th March 2020

C. Eligibility for Participation: All players should be currently registered and studying in the same college. All players must carry a valid i-card before the start of every match. In-case of protest against admission of a player into a particular college, said player must produce copy of fee-receipt, current semester marksheet or website registration details as proof of admission within 4 hours of intimation to avoid disqualification

D. Registration Fee: INR 3500 per team

E. Prize Money: Winners: INR 26000; Runners-up: INR 14000

F. General Regulations:

- a. Teams are liable to disqualification against breach of disciplinary conduct if players/management are involved in illegal activities as per institute norms in IIT Bombay.
- b. Smoking/consumption of alcohol or any prohibited substances inside the campus are strictly prohibited. Entire team will be disqualified from the tournament even if a single player is found to be violating these rules.
- c. Each team has to get their personal kits; Proper kit is compulsory that is a shirt, shorts, socks, shin guards, and football boots (studs).
- d. Goalkeepers from both sides should wear a kit that will distinguish them from the outfield players and the referees.



- e. Please take care of your kits and belongings, if lost they would not be the management's responsibility.
- f. All teams must report 45-60 Minutes before the scheduled time. Penalty will be charged by the referees if the team is late.
- g. In all cases, the referee's decision would be final. The committee can decide after discussing it with the officials.

G. Rules of Play:

- a. The tournament will be of knockout format
- b. Team will consist of 16 players. 11 players will play at a given time.
- c. The maximum number of substitutions is 3 (no rolling substitutions).
- d. The length of the match is 50 minutes, played in two equal halves of 25 minutes (25-5-25) which is subjected to be changed as per weather and conditions or any other circumstances by the referees.
- e. No extra time will be given. In case of a tie; we will have penalty shootouts.
- f. Matches will be played according to the rules followed by the International Football Federation.
- g. No player can participate from two teams. Should this occur, it would lead to the disqualification of both the teams.
