## Cricket Championship Official Rule-book

This rulebook is binding and will be strictly followed in the course of the tournament

**A. List of Events:** Cricket (Men)

**B. Dates:** 20th- 29th March

**C. Eligibility for Participation:** All players should be currently registered and studying in the same college. All players must carry a valid i-card before the start of every match. In-case of protest against admission of a player into a particular college, said player must produce copy of fee-receipt, current semester marksheet or website registration details as proof of admission within 4 hours of intimation to avoid disqualification

**D. Registration Fee:**

Fixed registration fee - INR 6500/-

Match fee - INR 500 per match

**E. Prize Money:** Winners - INR 25000; Runners-up - INR 15000

**F. General Regulations:**

- a. Teams are liable to disqualification against breach of disciplinary conduct if players/management are involved in illegal activities as per institute norms in IIT Bombay.
- b. Smoking/consumption of alcohol or any prohibited substances inside the campus are strictly prohibited. Entire team will be disqualified from the tournament even if a single player is found to be violating these rules.
- c. Since matches will be played with white balls every team has to be in the same coloured jerseys.
- d. Metal spikes are not allowed, normal sports shoes and rubber spikes are permitted.
- e. Each team has to get their personal kits, including the bats.



- f. We will provide the match balls.
- g. Please take care of your kits and belongings, if lost they would not be the management's responsibility.
- h. Drinking water will be available. Just carry water bottles with you.
- i. All teams must report 30 Minutes before the scheduled time.
- j. Please respect the officials and the other players. In all cases, the umpire's decision would be final. Disputes will be resolved by the organizing committee after discussions with the officials.
- k. There is no specific age limit

**G. Rules of Play:**

- a. All the matches will be played in T20 knockout format
- b. Each team can have a squad of 16 players.
- c. The playing 11 cannot be changed once submitted before the match.
- d. The captain needs to give a list of the players while submitting the tournament form.
- e. No player can participate from two teams. Should this occur, it would lead to the disqualification of both the teams.
- f. All no balls will be free hits.
- g. In case of a tie, super over will decide the winner as per ICC rule
- h. In case of rain D/L method as per ICC rules are applicable.
- i. During play, umpire's every decision is final
- j. All other rules and regulations are as per the international 20-overs format
- k. Field restrictions: For the first six overs, only two players can field outside the 30-yard circle. After 6 overs a maximum of 5 fielders can field outside the inner circle
