## Hockey Championship Official Rule-book

This rulebook is binding and will be strictly followed in the course of the tournament

- A. List of Events:** Hockey(Men)
- B. Schedule of Events:** 26th March - 29th March 2020
- C. Eligibility for Participation:** All players must carry a valid i-card before the start of every match. In-case of protest against admission of a player into a particular college, said player must produce copy of fee-receipt, current semester marksheet or website registration details as proof of admission within 4 hours of intimation to avoid disqualification
- D. Registration Fee:** INR 2000 per team
- E. Prize Money:** Winners: INR 16000; Runners-up: INR 11000
- F. General Regulations:**
- Teams are liable to disqualification against breach of disciplinary conduct if players/management are involved in illegal activities as per institute norms in IIT Bombay.
  - Smoking/consumption of alcohol or any prohibited substances inside the campus are strictly prohibited. Entire team will be disqualified from the tournament even if a single player is found to be violating these rules.
  - Each team has to get their personal kits; Proper kit is compulsory that is a shirt, shorts, stockings, shin guards, sticks and turf shoes/grass court sport shoes.
  - Goalkeepers from both sides should carry their respective kits with shirts that will distinguish them from the outfield players and the referees.
  - Please take care of your kits and belongings, if lost they would not be the management's responsibility.



- f. All teams must report 45-60 Minutes before the scheduled time. Penalty will be charged by the referees if the team is late.
- g. In all cases, the referee's decision would be final. The committee can decide after discussing it with the officials.

**G. Rules of Play:**

- a. The tournament will be of knockout format
- b. Team will consist of 16 players. 11 players will play at a given time.
- c. There would be rolling substitutions.
- d. The length of the match is 60 minutes, played in four quarters of 15 minutes (15-2-15-5-15-2-15) which is subjected to be changed as per weather and conditions or any other circumstances by the referees.
- e. No extra time will be given. In case of a tie; we will have penalty shootouts.
- f. Matches will be played according to the rules followed by the Federation of International Hockey(FIH).
