Lawn Tennis Championship Official Rule-book

This rulebook is binding and will be strictly followed in the course of the tournament

- Men's Doubles

- **Dates:**

- 27TH-29TH March 2020

- **Eligibility for Participation:**

- Open for All

- **Registration Fee:**

- Men's Singles: Rs. 1000/-
- Women's Singles: Rs. 500/-
- Men's Doubles: Rs. 1500/-

- **Prize Money:**

- Men's Singles- Winner: Rs. 8000/- Runner's Up: Rs. 6000/-
- Women's Singles- Winner: Rs. 5000/- Runner's Up: Rs. 3000/-
- Men's Doubles- Winner: Rs. 14000/- Runner's Up: Rs. 8000/-

- **General Regulations:**

- Teams are liable to disqualification against breach of disciplinary conduct if players/management are involved in illegal activities as per institute norms in IIT Bombay.
- Smoking/consumption of alcohol or any prohibited substances inside the campus are strictly prohibited. Entire team will be disqualified from the tournament even if a single player is found to be violating these rules.



- **Rules of Play:**

- The rules of the International Tennis Federation as adopted from time to time by the All India Lawn Tennis Association shall apply.

Men's Singles:

- All matches till the quarter finals will be the best of 15 games.
 - 8 games to win(with a difference of minimum 2 games), for example 8-6, 8-5, etc.
 - If the score is 7-7, the score must be 9-7 to win the match.
 - If the score is 8-8, a 7-point tiebreak will be played with standard tiebreak rules.
- All matches from quarter finals onwards will be best of 3 regular sets. All the sets consist of:-
 - 6 games to win(with a difference of minimum 2 games), for example 6-4, 6-3, etc.
 - If the score is 5-5, the score must be 7-5 to win that set.
 - If the score is 6-6, a 7-point tiebreak will be played with standard tie breaker rules.

Women's Singles:

- All matches till the quarter finals will be the best of 15 games.
 - 8 games to win(with a difference of minimum 2 games), for example 8-6, 8-5, etc.
 - If the score is 7-7, the score must be 9-7 to win the match.
 - If the score is 8-8, a 7-point tiebreak will be played with standard tiebreak rules.
- All matches from quarter finals onwards will be best of 3 regular sets. All the sets consist of:-
 - 6 games to win(with a difference of minimum 2 games), for example 6-4, 6-3, etc.
 - If the score is 5-5, the score must be 7-5 to win that set.
 - If the score is 6-6, a 7-point tiebreak will be played with standard tie breaker rules.

Men's Doubles:

- All matches till the quarter finals will be the best of 15 games.
 - 8 games to win(with a difference of minimum 2 games), for example 8-6, 8-5, etc.



- If the score is 7-7, the score must be 9-7 to win the match.
- If the score is 8-8, a 7-point tiebreak will be played with standard tiebreak rules.
- All matches from quarter finals onwards will be best of 3 regular sets. The first 2 sets consist of:-
 - 6 games to win(with a difference of minimum 2 games), for example 6-4, 6-3, etc.
 - If the score is 5-5, the score must be 7-5 to win that set.
 - If the score is 6-6, a 7-point tiebreak will be played with standard tie breaker rules.
- If the match goes till the 3rd set, it will be a super tie breaker with 10 points to win(with a difference of minimum 2 points). Standard tie breaker rules to be followed.
- Should the game score reach 40-40 (deuce), the game will be decided by a single-point deuce(the receiving team gets to choose the side).

- **Dress Code:**
 - Shorts, T-shirt, Tennis/Non-marking shoes

- **Rescheduling Rules:**
 - If a player is late by over 20 mins for his match, only then will a walkover be given to the opponent. But, each player must ensure that they are on time for the match.
 - If a player wishes to delay a match due to genuine reasons, the following rules will apply:
 - Delay- The player must inform the organisers & the opponents at least 4 hours before the match.
 - Please do note that for smooth conduction of the tournament, the Schedule of Play must be strictly followed by all.
 - All matches upto and including the quarterfinals will be self-refereed and the semi-finals and finals will be refereed by a chair umpire.
